### Call for Entries

#### 4x6/6x4 Postcard Sized Art, a Legacy Campaign Charity Event Exhibition

The Art Gallery at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction, Colorado is pleased to issue a Call for Artist participation in an invitational exhibition.

The 4x6/6x4 Postcard Legacy Campaign Exhibit will be an exhibition of original artworks, made and donated by artists from around the world. Each artwork will be postcard sized at 4x6 or 6x4 inches. All of the postcard-sized artworks will be for sale to the public at \$20 each to benefit the Legacy Campaign.

We invite artists from around the world to participate by sending artwork that is sized at 4x6 or 6x4 inches, unframed and light enough to be hung with T-pins (gallery walls are carpeted). All artwork submitted must be available for the duration of the show, for sale at the price of \$20 each, and will be the property of the Colorado Mesa University Art Department if unsold at the close of the exhibition.

All proceeds benefit the **Art Department Legacy Campaign at Colorado Mesa University to establish a permanent endowment for the Art Department**. This endowment will be established for the purpose of supporting a variety of Art Department programs including visiting artists, exhibitions, equipment purchases and other events that directly support the efforts of the **Art Department at Colorado Mesa University** to educate their student body.

### Exhibition Dates:

Monday, February 20, 2012 to Friday, March 23, 2012

### Reception:

Friday, February 24, 2012 from 6:00 to 9:00pm

### Purchasing Artwork:

The exhibition will open for previewing (no purchasing) on **Monday, February 20, 2012 at 9:00am** and sales will begin **Friday, February 24, 2012 at 6:00 pm**. Artwork not purchased at the opening event will then be available to purchase during the gallery open hours until the exhibit closes at **4pm on Friday, March 23, 2012**.

**Entries:**

Open to Artists from around the world using a variety of media, but must adhere to the dimension, weight and agreement guidelines below. A maximum of four entries per artist may be submitted.

There is no entry fee. The artwork submission is all that is required.

**Entry Deadline:**

**4:00PM, Friday, February 10, 2012**

**Agreement:**

**Submission of artwork, shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to comply with the terms of this prospectus including:**

- All artwork submissions must be accompanied with a complete Entry Label with all information.
- All artwork must be either 4x6 inches or 6x4 inches in size and unframed.
- If an artwork is matted, the exterior dimensions including mat must be either 4x6 inches or 6x4 inches in size and easily hung via T-pins.
- Please use fixative if appropriate. Artworks submitted with unfixed charcoal, pastel or other flaky substances that can or will impact other artworks in the exhibition will not be accepted and removed from the exhibit to protect other artwork submissions.
- The Art Gallery at Colorado Mesa University retains the right to reject artwork submissions that do not meet the guidelines of the prospectus, are deemed inappropriate, cannot be installed with T-pins or that arrived in damaged condition.
- Three-Dimensional artwork submissions must be light enough to be hung via T-pins in a carpet wall.
- Artworks that are unsold will remain the property of the Colorado Mesa University Art Department if unsold at the close of the exhibition and will not be returned to artists for any reason.
- Images used for promotion of the exhibit will be taken from submitted entries and will be credited to the artist when possible.
- All sales will be final and no refunds will be available for any reason.
- No artwork submitted may be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition.

**Artwork Retrieval:**

Purchased artworks from **The 4x6/6x4 Postcard Legacy Campaign Exhibit** will remain on display until **Friday, March 23, 2012 at 4:00pm**. Artwork Pick-Up days are: Friday, March 23 from 4:00 to 5:00pm, Saturday, March 24 & Sunday, March 25 from Noon to 4:00pm. If buyers are unable to pick up purchased artworks on these days, they will have the option of paying an extra \$5 to have the work mailed to them upon the close of the exhibition. Artworks will be shipped via USPS within two weeks of the close of the exhibition. Please allow two weeks for your artwork to arrive if choosing to mail your purchased artwork. Sold artwork may not be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition.

### Hand-Delivered Artwork

Hand-Delivered Entries may be submitted **Monday, February 6, 2012 through Friday, February 10, 2012** at the Administrative Assistant's Desk in the Fine Art building. Each entry must have an Entry Form attached complete with all requested information.
