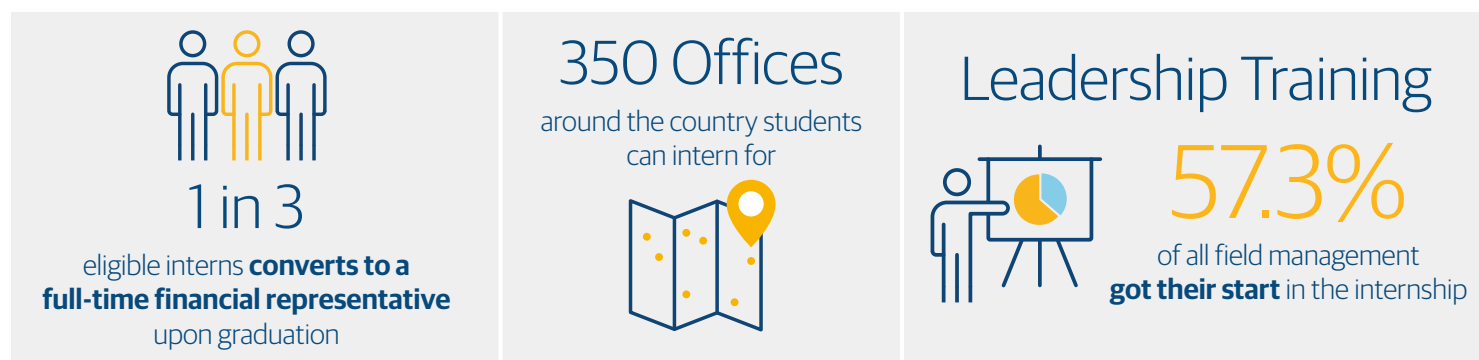

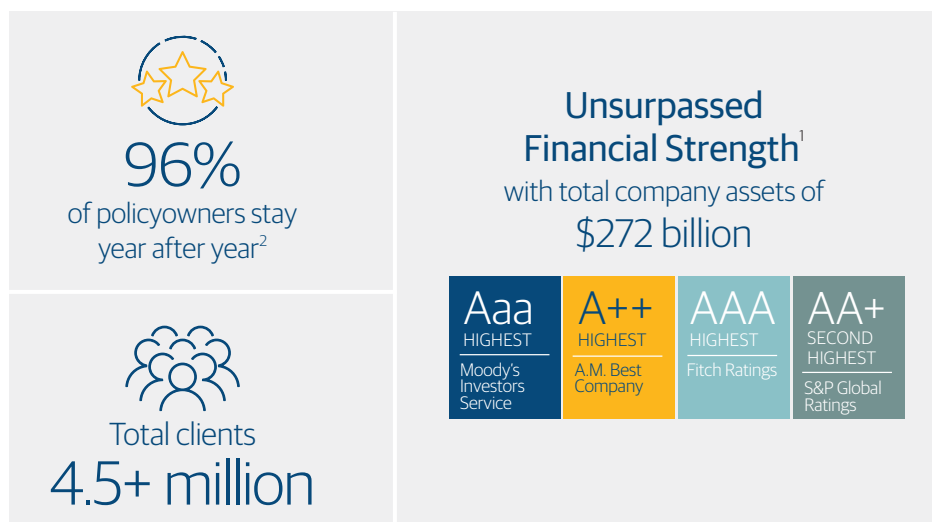
IMPACT ON YOU
