Examples are 'Dying Well" documentary with reflection and discussion, "Loss Toss" which is an exercise to develop empathy for patients experiencing losses (big and small) followed by de-brief; Added documentary called "Being Mortal" and Consider the Conversation" to help students understand importance of teaching patients about Advance Directives.

Followed by a discussion and pairing students together to begin their own Advance Directives called "Conversation Starter Kit." Students often comment on how glad they are to have a tool to use to start this conversation for themselves and their family. Bring in guest speaker from local hospice to talk to students about hospice and palliative care nursing. Introduce students to laws and past legal cases involving death and dying (i.e., Colorado End of Life Options Act) followed by a discussion of ethics and role of nurses.
