CPR Requirements & Training Options

CPR Requirement: valid adult & child required

- 1. CPR certification must be valid through the end of student teaching.
- 2. TC's must submit proof of certification by August 1st for fall start; January 1st for spring start.
- 3. Registration for internship will not be permitted until proof of CPR certification is submitted.
- 4. First Aid Certification is strongly recommended, but not required

CPR Training Options:

A. CPR In-Person Training:

- a. On campus through BLS Club: 3 dates each semester, specifically for Teacher Education students. Register here with this <u>link</u>.

B. CPR Online:
